



- Milestone achievements since last update:
 - Contractors had expected all works would be complete by this date.
The Council understands resident's frustration and appreciates your patience while the works are completed. Please be assured that everyone is working hard to complete the works and reopen as soon as possible.
 - Facilities building - snagging assessment completed on Monday July 20th.
Rework commenced on July 30th.
Lead time for materials remains the critical path driver.
Initially Contractors estimated 4 weeks for completion, however some items required are now on a longer lead.
All Teams are working to identify a temporary solution that would allow the Recreation Ground to reopen as soon as possible.
Note: The completion date is still to be confirmed.
 - A pathway is required to facilitate safe access for the public. Pathway installation currently underway, alongside rectification works.
Note: These works are necessary for safe visitor access.
 - Works to repair the extensive wear and tear caused by heavy plant and machinery, has commenced.
Note: Time is needed for grass seed to germinate and establish.
 - Tennis courts: work completed 31st July. Courts playable 1 to 2 weeks.
 - Preparatory works for the re-siting of the Cricket Storage shed have been carried out. Installation of new shed is TBA.
 - U9's playground and other equipment:
The independent post-installation inspection was completed this week.
Next Steps: A full report will be compiled and submitted to the Supplier.
Actions: Upon receipt, the Supplier is to review the independent report, address any findings, and confirm final sign-off for safe use. Dates remain to be confirmed.
 - Garrick Green Gate at this time will remain closed, as agreed at the Council Meeting on 9th June. This will be considered at the Council Meeting on August 18th.
